<p>#1 Top Side Off Outside Peel</p> 	<p>#2 Bottom Side Off Outside Peel</p> 
<p>#3 Right Side Off Outside Peel</p> 	<p>#4 Left Side Off Outside Peel</p> 
<p>Rewind Position #1-#4= Wound OUT. Rewind Position #5-#8= Wound IN</p>	
<p>#5 Top Side Off Inside Peel</p> 	<p>#6 Bottom Side Off Inside Peel</p> 
<p>#7 Right Side Off Inside Peel</p> 	<p>#8 Left Side Off Inside Peel</p> 

Keep In Mind:

The orientation or wind position of your label depends on your application method. For example, a certain label applicator may require a rewind position of #3 or right edge off first. If your labels are being applied by hand, the rewind position may not be as important. Rolls are wound depending on factors such as the text and image direction of the labels itself, the length and width of the label and how the label comes off the roll.
